

Instructions For Completing  
Wagonmaster \$5000 Scholarship

Wichita Wagonmasters  
Academic Year 2007-2008

**Purpose:** In early 1974 chartering for Wichita Wagonmasters and the Windwagon was formed by a group of civic-minded business executives. The purpose of this organization was to promote and sell the good life in Wichita and support the Wichita River Festival and other projects of benefit to the city. The founders were not joiners, but active participants and leaders in their various vocations and avocations. The civic and social activities of the founders, and now our total membership, are as wide and varied as the personalities of the members themselves.

To insure the values of the organization and to help maintain and build a healthy social and civic community, we offer this scholarship to a young adult with priority given to students who have demonstrated a desire and a future of strong civic and social involvement.

**General Instructions:**

1. Fill out the application completely following the instructions provided below. **All entries should be typed or filled out electronically and printed.** Electronic versions can be downloaded at [www.wagonmasters.org](http://www.wagonmasters.org).

2. Make sure your application includes the following attachments:

Your essay as described in Section IV.

One letter of recommendation as described in Section V.

And official transcript from your high school.

## **Applications Instructions:**

### **Section I. Student Information**

- a. Enter your full name as it appears on your transcript.
- b. Enter your permanent, legal home address including your phone number.
- c. Enter the name of your parents(s) or legal guardian and their relationship to you.
- d. Enter the address of your parents(s) or legal guardian including telephone numbers.
- e. Enter the primary occupation of your parent(s) or legal guardian.
- f. Signature of parent or legal guardian.
- g. Enter the information about the Kansas college or university you plan to attend.
- h. Enter the name of the high school from which you graduated or will graduate and the years you attended that school.
- i. Enter the address of the high school.
- j. Enter your class ranking, grade point average (GPA) and GPA scale.

### **Section II. Recommendation of School Official**

Your application should include a note by a school official recommending your application and including an official transcript. It is **mandatory** that this section be **completed** and **signed** by a school official in the space allotted on the application. The official **must** initial the line acknowledging the requirement to include your transcript with the application. **Failure to complete this section shall cause your application to be disqualified.**

### **Section III. School Achievements**

- a. Enter the activities in which you have participated while in school.
- b. Enter the awards and/or honors you have received while in school.

### **Section IV. Community Service and Work Experience**

- a. List all the community service activities in which you have participated while in school. Include all activities of community service.
- b. List types of part-time work (number of hours/week) and position(s) held.

### **Section V. Scholarship Essay**

Provide a written essay of not less than 250 words, nor more than 500 words, on the importance of civic and social activities and its value to the community and the volunteer.

### **Section VI. Applicant's Statement**

In this section you are agreeing to five requirements necessary to qualify for this Wagonmaster scholarship and certifying that the information you have provided is, to the best of your knowledge, true and correct. If after reading this statement you agree, sign and date the application. **Failure to sign this will cause your application to be disqualified.**
